

ALPINE PEACE CROSSING – **Charity for refugee support** (APC) is a civic, independent and non- profit **social and peace initiative**, founded by Ernst Loeschner in 2007 under the patronage of the State presidents of Austria and Italy, Heinz Fischer and Giorgio Napolitano. It is based on a long forgotten Jewish exodus over the Austrian Alps near Krimml (Salzburg) in 1947 and is dedicated to refugees worldwide.

Since 2011 APC's focus has been on social projects, most recently for housing and job creation, addressing the most basic needs of people.

The **three main points** of our social and peace initiative are:

- **Social- and refugee support:** the direct financial support for people in need including refugees and asylum seekers, since 2015 also disaster relief abroad,
- the annual **APC Peace Hike** over the Krimmler Tauern pass, together with refugees and asylum seekers,
- the annual **Krimml Peace Dialogue** on current refugee issues.
